

## A Look at LNH Revenues

LNH's FY25 revenues reflect a diverse and sustainable funding model that supports our mission and strategic priorities:


- **Individual Donations (8%)** - Gifts from alumni and supporters who believe in the importance of informed and engaged leadership across New Hampshire.
- **Tuition (35%)** - Fees paid by participants that help underwrite the cost of delivering a high-quality, immersive program experience.
- **Corporate Partnerships (28%)** - Support from businesses that value leadership development and are committed to strengthening communities across the state.
- **Grants (11%)** - Funding from foundations that recognize LNH's role in cultivating civic leadership and statewide impact.
- **Interest & Endowment Income (16%)** - Resources generated through responsible financial stewardship and long-term investment in the organization's future.
- **Events (2%)** - Revenue from ticket sales, tied to special events that bring together alumni and community members.



## A Look at LNH Expenses

LNH's FY25 expenses reflect our commitment to our mission, focusing on our three strategic priorities:

- **Elevate the Experience:** Recruiting, selecting, and delivering a high-impact experience for each year's class, and providing scholarships to ensure cost is not a barrier.
- **Amplify our Alumni:** Strengthening connections, fostering engagement, and creating new opportunities for alumni to lead and learn together.
- **Secure our Success:** Investing in the systems, partnerships, and strategies that ensure LNH remains strong, sustainable, and ready to meet the state's evolving leadership needs.
